The \$125 000 made available to Regent will go towards the following projects:

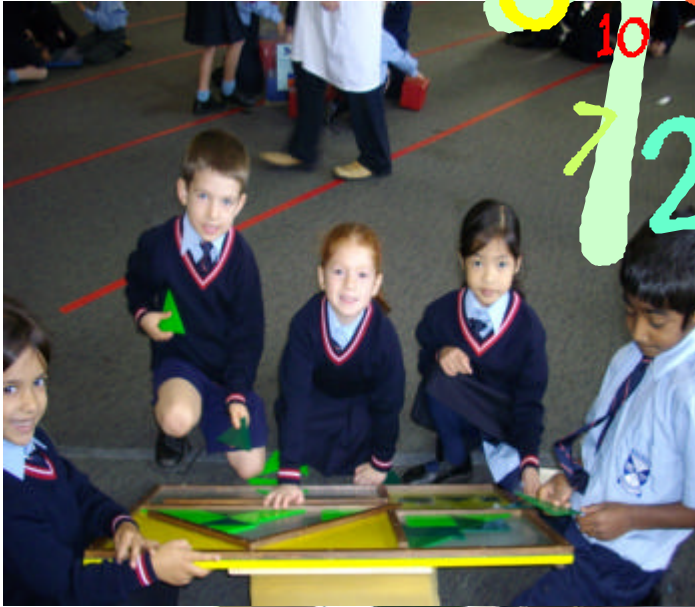
1. Shade Sails (senior playground, court yard and kindy stair area)

SCHOOL ROAD SAFETY & TRAVELSMART SURVEYS

Thank you to those families who have taken the time to complete the Road Safety surveys. We had 75 families return their surveys. This is a joint initiative between Regent College and the Town of Victoria Park to help resolve the congestion around the school at drop off and pick up times.

A great suggestion that has come from the survey is to park at Raphael Park or at McCallum Park (there is an underpass under Canning Highway at the end of Hordern Street) and then walk your children to or from school. This gets some exercise for yourself and your children and also helps with the traffic problems around the school.

Another change that we are working towards is for the school buses to arrive and leave from the school oval on Geddes Street. This will mean that the 'Bus Bays' on Hordern Street will be turned into 'Kiss and Ride' bays, meaning that you will not be able to park in these bays, they will be for you to drop off and pick up your children only. 'Kiss and Ride' bays will operate between 8.00 – 8.45am & 3.00 –

3.45pm. After these times the bays will be available for the school buses to use if required.

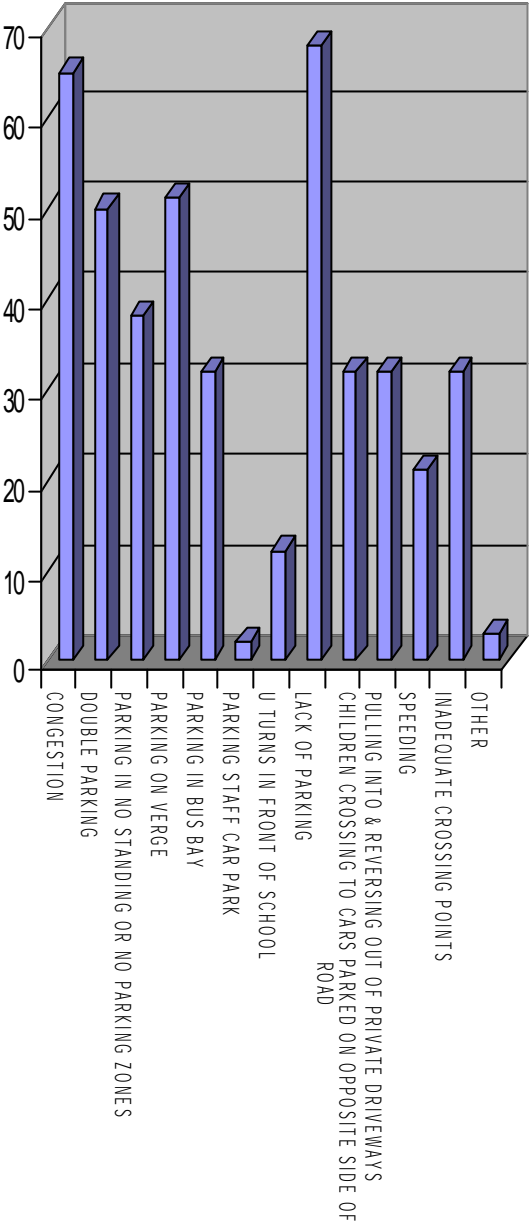

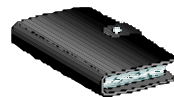
UNIFORM SHOP NEWS

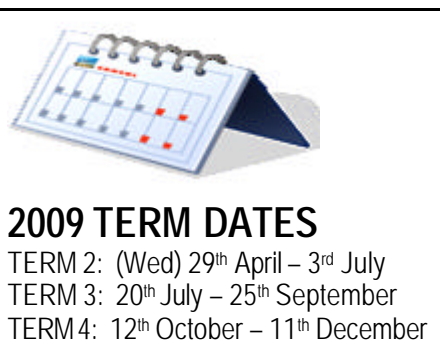
