



## COVID19 SAFETY FRAMEWORK

Dear Parents/Guardians

In response to the WA Government announcement this afternoon, we need to make further adjustments to our COVID protocols and we recognise that these will mainly affect parents. We have already made changes to assemblies, group activities, kiss and drive procedures and our timetable to reduce the numbers of students mingling throughout the school day.

Effective immediately, parents are requested to adhere to the following when dropping off and picking up children. These have been stipulated by the WA Government.

- 1) Parents are permitted on-site only to drop off and pick up students. Please make it brief.
- 2) Parents should not gather on the school grounds. We do encourage you to have a covid-friendly catchup elsewhere.
- 3) Parents are asked not to enter classrooms or any indoor space at the College. This includes the Administration building. This is a regrettable but necessary action to keep our students as safe as possible.
- 4) Parents are asked to wear masks while on the school site.

The uniform shop will be closed until further notice. We will work to minimise inconvenience to families in the coming week.

#### **MEET THE TEACHER (Pre-primary to Year 6)**

Later this week, class teachers will post a Meet the Teacher message for parents to view through Seesaw. Under normal circumstances, we would meet with families face-to-face, but we hope this digital format provides sufficient and helpful information as we begin the year.

Parents from Years 3-6 have received communications detailing a device (iPad) loan option for usage in the event of a partial or complete school closure. Parents must complete Loan Device Agreements before any announced closure to exercise this offer.

For families who have already submitted requests for loan devices, students will begin bringing home loan devices tomorrow (Tuesday 8th February). Students with loan devices do need to bring them back and forth to school each day.
