The Regent College Uniform

Wearing the College uniform correctly is a condition of enrolment and fosters a sense of belonging for students.

Parents are requested to check that their child is dressed correctly in the College uniform each day, ensuring that all components are neat and in good order.

If a student digresses from the College uniform, the student will receive a ve'rbal reminder and a Uniform infringement notification will be sent home by their classroom teacher.

Please treat this as a gentle reminder but it is a genuine request that any incorrect components are to be addressed.





Make Up

Makeup is not permitted, however clear nails and clear



Adornments / Jewellery

A watch may be worn.

Please note that smart watches are **not** part of the uniform and are not permitted unless there is an arrangement with the Principal.

Students may wear one pair of plain silver or gold studs or plain small full circle piercing sleepers in the earlobe only. Maximum diameter of sleeper 12mm, maximum diameter of stud 4mm.

No other jewellery is acceptable, including purity rings or rubber fundraising bands.



Casual/Free Dress Guidelines

Clothing is to be modest.

No skin tight tops.

No singlet or halter neck dresses or tops.

No offensive slogans or images on any clothing.

No bare midriffs.





Hairstyles

All hair must be neatly styled. Children are not permitted to have fashion haircuts such as undercuts. If you are unsure about a style, please ask before having your child's haircut.

Girls hair that touches the collar, should be tied up/ back using a plain red (school red) hair accessory. Hair should be kept away from the face.

Boys hair should be worn short, not touching the collar and maintained in a clean, tidy manner at all times. The length should not exceed the top of the collar or be below the eyebrows. In addition, no part of their hair is to be closely cut to the scalp or shaved. A 'Number 2' cut is the closest cut accepted.

Hair Colour

As hair dye often takes considerable time to fade out, children are not to colour their hair.



Kindergarten & Pre-Primary Uniform

Worn throughout the year

- Red bucket hat
- Red shirt (long or short sleeve)
- Navy shorts or navy track suit pants
- School track suit jacket (optional)
- Wet weather jacket to be worn over track suit jacket (optional)



- White ankle socks
- White velcro sneakers



No black shoes







Year 1 - 6 Physical Education (PE) Uniform

Girls & Boys

- Navy bucket hat
- Red shirt (long or short sleeve)
- Navy shorts
 OR navy track suit pants
- School track suit jacket (optional)
- Wet weather jacket to be worn over track suit jacket (optional)
- White ankle socks
- Predominantly white sneakers with laces














Winter Uniform Girls

YEAR 1-6 Uniform

Blue hat

Tie

Blue shirt (short or long sleeve)

Tights with formal black leather lace-up shoes
OR blue socks with formal black leather lace-up shoes

Jumper (optional)

Wet Weather Jacket (optional)

YEAR 1-3 | Options

Pinafore with blue shirt (long or short sleeve) Year 3 girls have the option to wear the skirt in place of the pinafore.

Navy pants with blue shirt (long or short sleeve)

YEAR 4-6 | Options

Skirt with blue shirt (long or short sleeve)

Navy pants with blue shirt (long or short sleeve)

Other Optional Extras

Navy scarves, gloves and wet weather jackets are optional extras and can be purchased from the uniform shop.

Uniform Length

Girls uniforms are to be no more than 10cm above or below the knee.

YEAR 1-6 Uniform

- Blue hat
- Tie
- Blue shirt (short or long sleeve)
- Navy trousers
- Jumper (optional)
- Wet Weather Jacket (optional)

Optional Extras

Navy scarves, gloves and wet weather jackets are optional extras and can be purchased from the uniform shop.



School Bags

Kindergarten & Pre-Primary

Bags need to be labelled and large enough to carry:

- Water bottle
- Lunch bag
- Spare set of clothes including underwear
- Library bag
- Reading/note folder (A4) size.

Year 1 - Year 6

It is preferred that students in Year 1 - Year 6 purchase the College bag online from the Uniform Shop.

Blue Folder

Kindergarten - Year 6

Each student is required to have a blue folder. This can be purchased online from the Uniform Shop.

Library Bag

Each student will receive a library bag when starting at Regent College. Replacement library bags can be purchased online from the Uniform Shop.





School Hats

Regent College bucket hats are available for purchase online at the Uniform Shop.

Kindergarten - Pre-Primary Wear red bucket hats.

Year 1 - Year 6Wear navy bucket hats.

Art Shirts

Students may be required to wear art shirts during the week. Art shirts are available for purchase online from the Uniform Shop, or elsewhere.

Labelling Uniforms

The College highly recommends labelling each item of uniform with the family name of the child.

Uniform Schedule

The Summer Uniform is to be worn in Terms 1 & 4. The Winter Uniform is to be worn in Terms 2 & 3. Please refer to the website for the PE Uniform schedule.

Purchasing Uniform

Parents/Guardians can purchase uniforms by completing an online order form available on the College website.

The expected turn around time is 5 working days during school term. You will be informed when your order is complete. Completed orders that have been paid for will be sent home with your child, otherwise left at Administration for you to pay and collected from there.

Fittings

Uniform fitting sessions will be made available from time to time througout the year during term. Exact days and timings will be communicated to parents/guardians.
